We are pleased to inform you that Mt. Pleasant ISD will continue implementing the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for School Year 2018-2019 in **all of its schools** for the 2018-2019 school year. In CEP schools, applications are no longer required.

Schools that participate in CEP provide healthy breakfasts and lunches each day at no charge for ALL students enrolled in that CEP school during the 2018-2019 School Year. This provision will allow us to feed healthy meals to all of our students during the school day at no charge to their families.
