2-1-1 Texas Call for Assistance

2-1-1 is a three-digit telephone number that individuals can call when they are not sure who to call. On a daily basis, individuals and families can call the 2-1-1 Texas Information and Referral Network to access information about community services who provide assistance with a myriad of needs such as where to find food, clothing, shelter and a host of other community resources. Following a brief confidential assessment of an individual's needs, the Information and Referral Specialist will refer the caller to the appropriate community service.

If you need information or assistance in locating disaster related resources call 2-1-1. Dial 2-1-1 if you need help or want to give help. The specialized purpose of 2-1-1 Texas is to work in a supportive role assisting key emergency management professionals in responding to community services.

While **Home Health Services** are generally
thought of as primarily serving the elderly
population, in some cases, services are
available to children with certain disabling
conditions or health problems. Home
Health services are defined as those health
and health related services provided:

- on an intermittent basis
- under physician's plan of treatment
- to homebound patients.

You may be eligible to receive these
services through Medicaid or Medicare.
In other cases, insurance or other third
party payment sources may help defray
the cost.
