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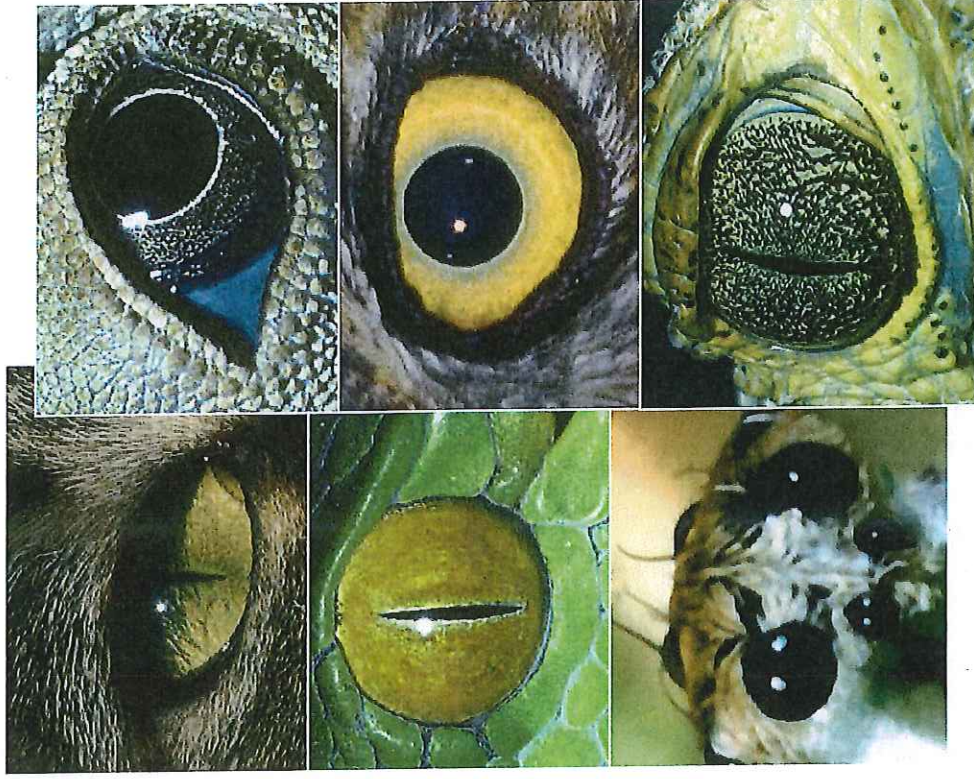

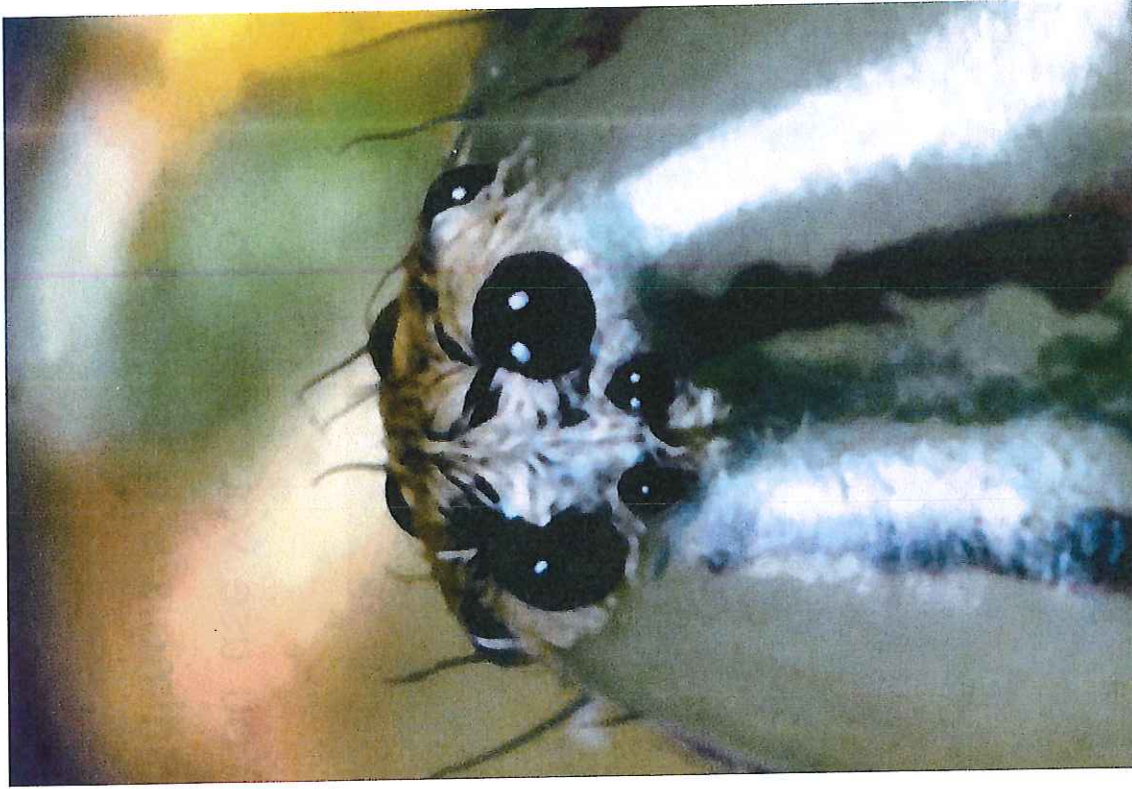

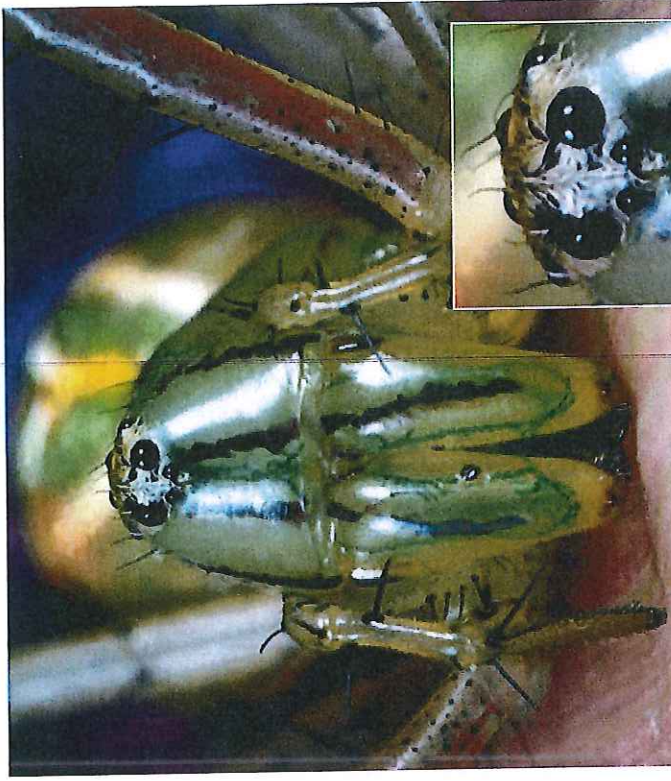

Lynx spider



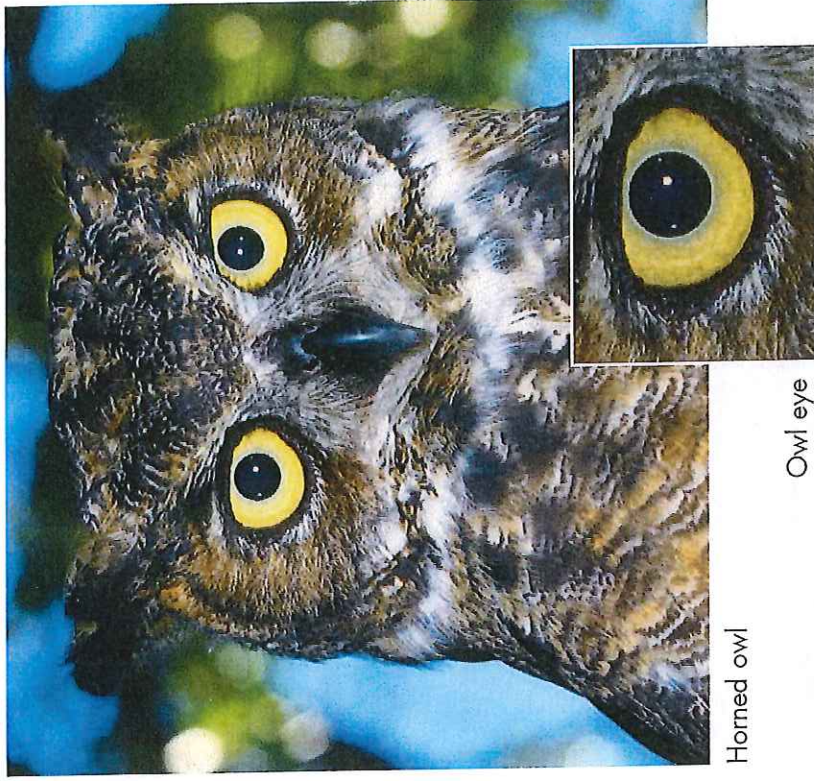
Spider eyes

But many spiders are very good at seeing things move.



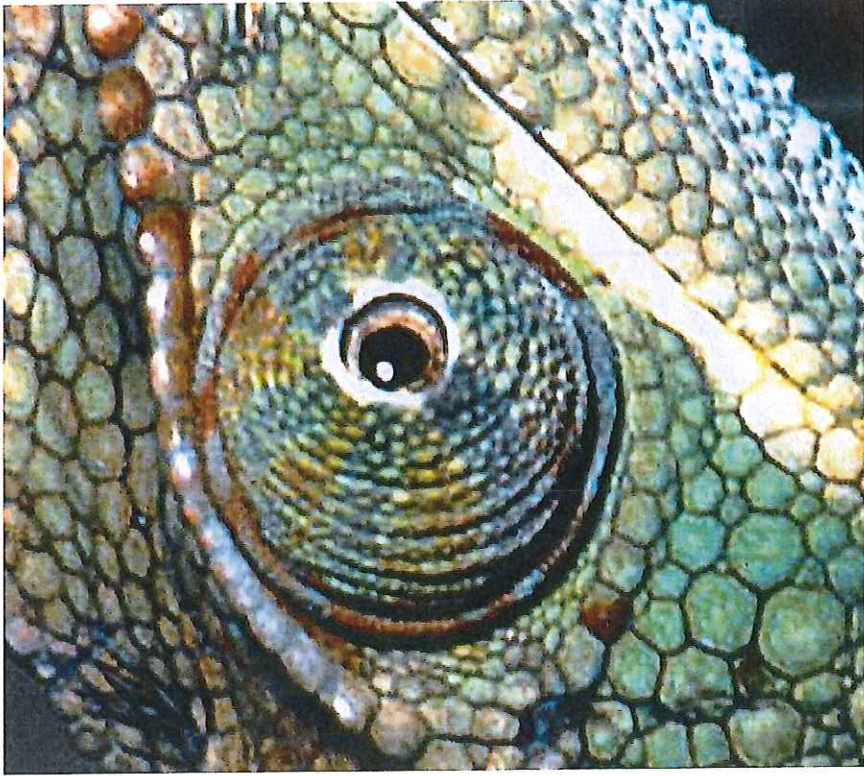

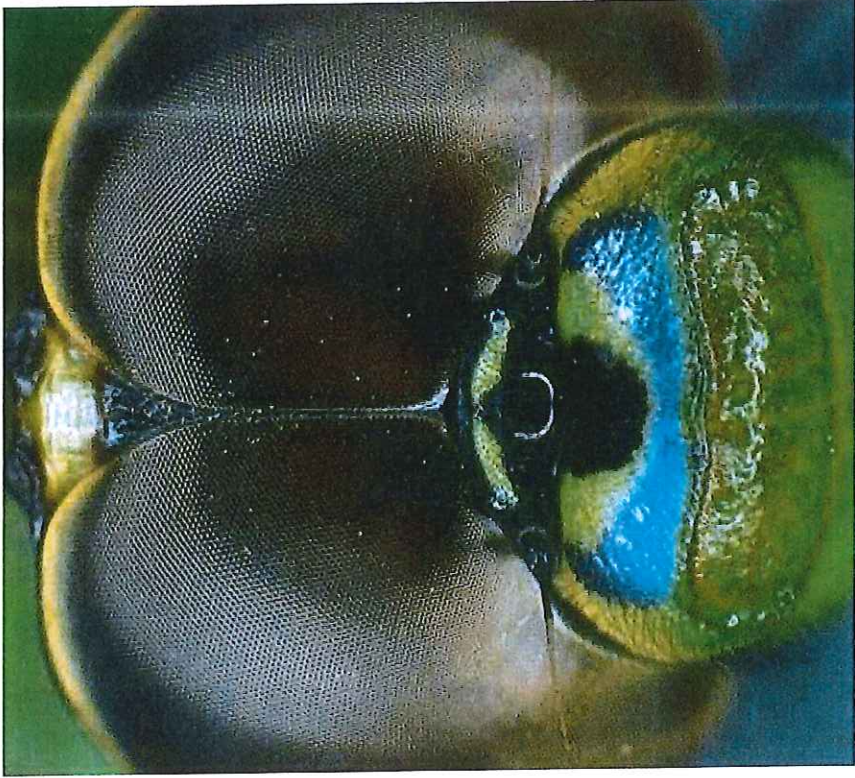
Chameleon

different at the same time.

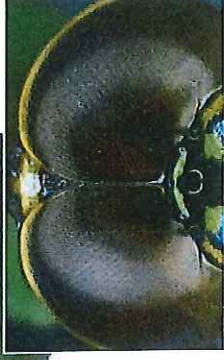
