

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


## STEP 1

#### **Interest Inventory**

Indicates your child's interests based on 11 categories.
The interest inventory interface changes based on grade level.
Students have the ability to update reading interests at any time using the Student Account tab.

Taken at first login for students in grades K and up, this initial placement test provides a Lexile® measure of your child's reading ability.





Students have the option to rate the book on a 5-star scale and share their thoughts about the book with a 140-character review. Faculty can publish student reviews so other readers can view.

#### **Other Pages**


Access additional pages such as an index, glossary, table of contents, etc.







## Literacy tools


Students can use a variety of literacy tools to annotate directly on the pages of books within the myON library.











#### 1. Journal

Take notes about a book, other topics, add citations, or even copy and paste text from a book directly into a journal entry.

#### 2. Drawing

Add drawings or shapes directly onto the text, illustrations, or photos on a page. Use the built-in eraser to remove any drawings or brush strokes.

#### 3. Highlighter

Use any of the four highlighter colors to focus in on important words, phrases, or sentences on a page. Learners can use the eraser to remove any highlights. Sticky notes will change to the corresponding color if dragged over on top of highlighted text.

#### 4. Sticky notes

Take notes while reading, ask questions for further research, respond to reading, and keep track of important information learned.

#### 5. Shape options


Use one of the shape options to draw lines, circles, boxes, or arrows around important information on a page. Use the built in eraser if you make a mistake or want to change the shape to a different color.


#### 6. Remove/Delete

All annotations automatically save within books. Students can click the trash icon to see choices for which annotations they wish to delete.




Students can click on the account tab to view their specific reading activity, avatar options, as well as update their interest inventory, monitor their individual reading growth, and view journal entries.





