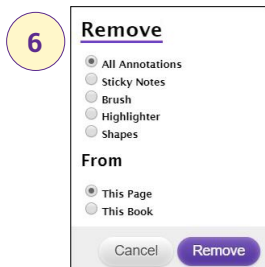
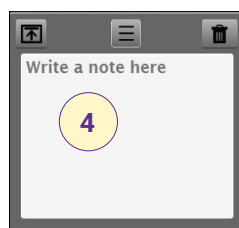
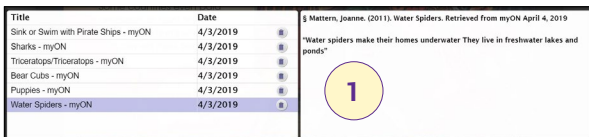
Students can use a variety of literacy tools to annotate directly on the pages of books within the myON library.



Tools

To use the tools, open a book and click on the tools icon. This will provide students access to all of their literacy tools.

Journal Drawing Highlighter Sticky notes Shape options Remove



1. Journal

Take notes about a book, other topics, add citations, or even copy and paste text from a book directly into a journal entry.

2. Drawing

Add drawings or shapes directly onto the text, illustrations, or photos on a page. Use the built-in eraser to remove any drawings or brush strokes.

3. Highlighter

Use any of the four highlighter colors to focus in on important words, phrases, or sentences on a page. Learners can use the eraser to remove any highlights. Sticky notes will change to the corresponding color if dragged over on top of highlighted text.

4. Sticky notes

Take notes while reading, ask questions for further research, respond to reading, and keep track of important information learned.

5. Shape options

Use one of the shape options to draw lines, circles, boxes, or arrows around important information on a page. Use the built in eraser if you make a mistake or want to change the shape to a different color.

6. Remove/Delete

All annotations automatically save within books. Students can click the trash icon to see choices for which annotations they wish to delete.

Student assessment

Book Quiz

Students can demonstrate their knowledge of the books they read. After a book is completed, students are prompted to take a quiz. The quizzes include five questions randomized from a pool of twelve.

The quizzes are optional based on faculty preferences and can be turned on or off.

Benchmark Assessment

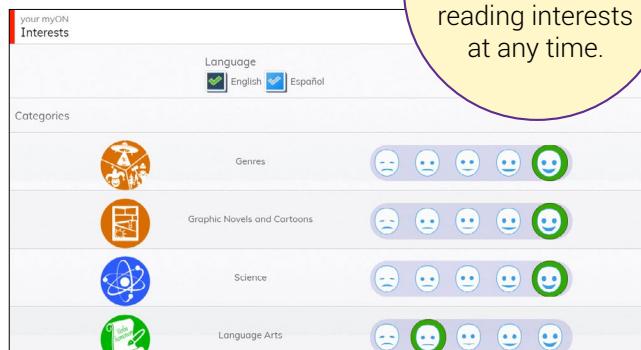
Prompt

Students will click on the envelope (when present), in the upper left corner of their landing page when it's time for them to take a benchmark assessment.



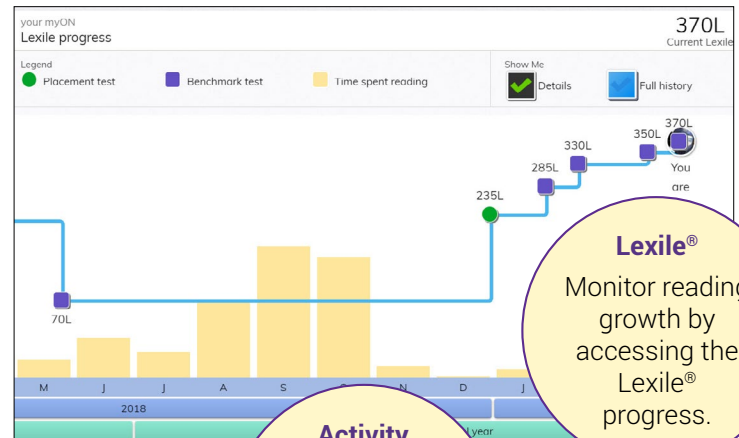
