- Recognized Jamie Carr from MPJH with an Above & Beyond award.

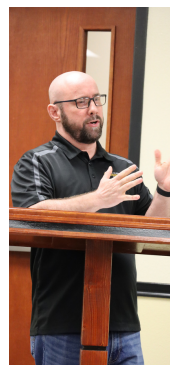

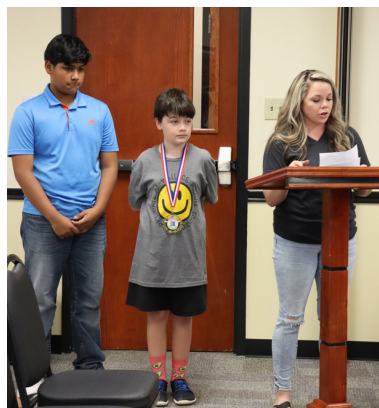
